John Lappie, PSU. Dr. John Lappie, Assistant Professor of Political Science at Plymouth State University. Dr. Lappie's teaching is focused on American politics, public policy, and research methods. Dr. Lappie is also an expert on the New Hampshire Primary; during the 2020 Presidential Primary. Dr. Lappie discussed the current political landscape, youth current aversion to organized politics, and its effect on their involvement in political activity.

Matt Wilhelm, Minority Leader, New Hampshire House of Representatives. (Via Zoom). Mr. Wilhelm provided a brief legislative update and discussed 5 key issues/priorities that are a blueprint for a stronger New Hampshire. Those priorities are 1. Protecting Our Rights and Freedoms; Maintaining Health of Our Communities; Bolstering Public Education; Lowering Costs for Granite Staters; Growing New Hampshire's Economy.

Sebastian Fuentes, Rights and Democracy. Mr. Fuentes is a community activist and advocate. He spoke about his support for climate action, public education, and immigration rights and reform. He is running for a seat on the Rules Committee of the New Hampshire Democratic Party.

Maddie McCluskey, NHDP (via Zoom). Ms. McCluskey shared the steps in the Town Caucus Process informed the group that she will attend the March 22nd meeting in person and to support the PAD towns as they accomplish their respective caucuses. (Manual on caucus meeting management available from NHDP)
